We do everything in our school to ensure that our students are not afraid to try anything new. Students participated in the CCA activities and proved that participation is more important than winning.






SCHOOL CELEBRATIONS & ACTIVITIES

We conducted activities such as - Spot the Difference, Dance, Essay Writing, Elocution, Role play......








International Dance Day








Teachers Orientation Programme






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PARENT'S TALK
