Like every other month this month too, students showcased their talent in CCA and events such as International Yoga Day, Father's Day, etc., that was celebrated by the school.





Parent's Orientation was conducted virtually and parents were briefed about the school policy, vision and mission and academic related information, activities throughout the year



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



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World Food Safety Day

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


World Environment Day

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



Father's Day




















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



International Yoga Day

























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CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (CCA)


