
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
Students Council Elections and Investiture Ceremony



Learn How to ask questions, Emotional development, Speech development, Respectful listening and Children take the lead.












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b) Vanmahotsav

Approximately 90 teachers from SIS Mehsana, Patan, Kadi and Unjha participated in this training programme.









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


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Principals Meeting for Educational Practices




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
















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PARENT'S TALK
