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





# 5. World Tourism Day


World Tourism Day is commemorated each year on 27 September to foster awareness among the international community of the importance of tourism and its social, cultural, political and economic value.





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
# 10. Birthday Celebration

Our mentors who works tirelessly were celebrated their birthdays during this month. Shanti International School Kadi wishes them all a wonderful year ahead.
















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#### PARENT'S TALK
