Like all the other month January is also filled with celebration, activities, competitions, examination etc.






# **Road Safety Week:**




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
# **National Youth Day:**

A flabbergasted festivity at Shanti International School Kadi campus!




Ultimately, it is to teach children that traditions are to be revived, re-lived and embraced.















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


















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# **Awakened Citizenship Programme:**

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


















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# **Army Day:**

The speech in English by Dhairya Patel from Grade VIII motivated the students further in instilling the spirit of patriotism within themselves.





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


# **Parents Teachers Meeting:**
